## **Reading text**

### Top tips

- 1. Write *a* before the job if it starts with a consonant: *he's a musician* (not *he's musician*).
- 2. Write *an* before the job if it starts with a vowel: *she's an artist* (not *she's artist*).
- 3. You can say *my sister is a* ... or *my sister's a* ...
- 4. Remember the 's' or 'es' for he or she: my dad works .... or she teaches ...
- 5. You can say when I'm older, when I grow up or one day ... to write about the future.
- 6. Write because to say why you want to do something: I want to be a pilot because ...
